Hello Robins.....we are moving to year 4 with you!

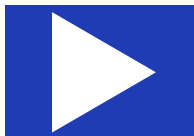
We have enjoyed being your teaching assistants in Year 3 so much that we thought we would like to help you again in Skylarks.

This is my new classroom

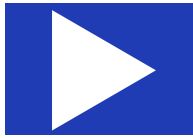


These are the cloakrooms

We will be learning about the geography of different places around the world, including France, Greece, Morocco and North America.

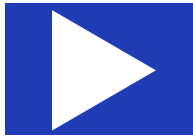
In Science we will learning about sounds, solids, liquids and gases, electricity, grouping animals and human digestion.
