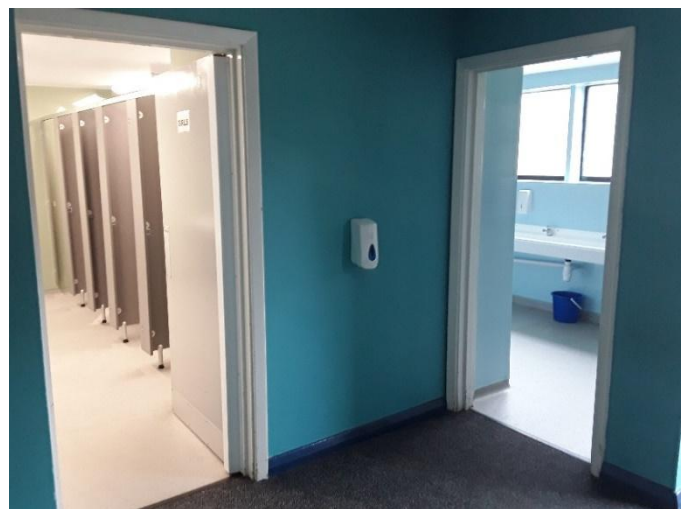

Learning in Year 6
